



Get To Know Alexa

Your Voice-Activated Virtual Concierge.

You can speak to Alexa through the circular-shaped Echo device in your home. To 'wake' Alexa, say the wake word, **"Alexa."** Once the blue ring light shows on the Echo, ask away!

Examples of What to Ask Alexa

Entertainment

- "Alexa, tell me a joke"
- "Alexa, give me a random fact"
- "Alexa, give me a spelling bee word"
- "Alexa, what's in the news?"
- "Alexa, give me tips on cleaning"
- "Alexa, what happened on this day in history?"

Music

- By Genre
Ex: "Alexa, play jazz music"
- By Artist
Ex: "Alexa, play Elvis"
- By Local Radio Station
Ex: "Alexa, play 99.5"

Community Information

- "Alexa, read today's events"
- "Alexa, has the mail arrived?"
- "Alexa, what are the notices?"
- "Alexa, call the front desk"

Local Knowledge

- "Alexa, what's the weather?"
- "Alexa, will it rain this evening?"
- "Alexa, when is the next full moon?"

Dining

- "Alexa, what's for breakfast today?"
- "Alexa, what's for lunch on Saturday?"
- "Alexa, what are today's specials?"

Other

- "Alexa, wake me up to NPR at 7am"
- "Alexa, set an alarm for 8 a.m."
- "Alexa, add 3 minutes to my timer"
- "Alexa, set the volume to 8"

(Volume can be set to any number 1-10, with 10 being the loudest.)

If you don't want to use Alexa, **push the microphone on/off button on top of the Echo device.** The Echo light ring will turn red and Alexa will not respond to your requests until you push the button again to turn the microphone back on.
